



## **Intervention, Treatment and Recovery Action Team**

### **SMART Goals for 2022**

#### ***Continued from 2021***

1. By December 31, 2022, there will be a 15% increase in Marin Medi-Cal beneficiaries who have a treatment encounter within 7, 14 and 30 days following a non-fatal opioid overdose.
2. By December 31, 2022, there will be an equitable distribution of Marin Medi-Cal beneficiaries having a treatment encounter within 7, 14 and 30 days following a non-fatal opioid overdose when disaggregated by race/ethnicity.
3. By December 31, 2022, support county agencies/Marin County Departments with naloxone kits and expand naloxone reach by hosting at least six (6) naloxone trainings.

#### ***New – Align with HMA Grant/Process Improvement Event***

4. By December 31, 2022, there will be three (3) additional avenues in Marin County that provide Narcan (naloxone) free of charge.
5. By December 31, 2022, within the Medi-Cal system of care, provide support to at least three (3) interested MAT providers in identifying 1-2 projects specifically aimed at reducing racial disparities in access to care.  
*- Recommend outreach to MTC, Ritter, MCHW, Spahr, BHH, MCC and Alcohol Justice (includes some partners who connect folks to MAT)*
6. By December 31, 2022, provide support for at least three (3) providers to increase their MAT Rx prescribing by 10%.
